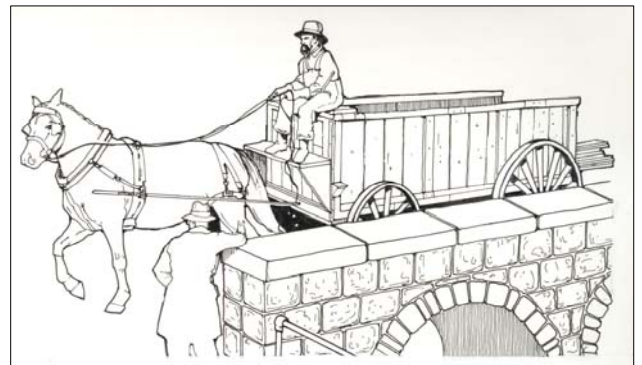


Commemorative Riverwalk Book for Naperville's 175th Anniversary

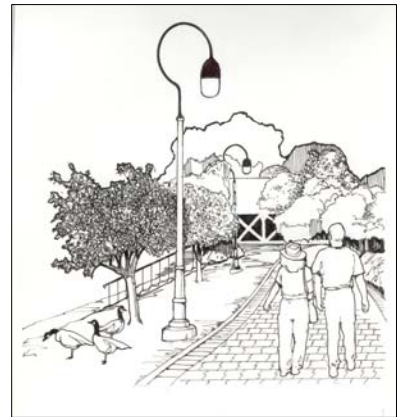
For two years, Jini Clare, author of *Naperville: Reflections of Community* and the *Naperville Area Handbook and Guide*, researched the history of the Riverwalk. She interviewed numerous individuals who were instrumental in its creation and gleaned information about the special features that abound along its paths. Jini also worked with a talented local artist to re-create scenes that once occurred along what is now the Riverwalk – from the Native Americans gathering nuts and berries along the banks of the DuPage River to the stone masons taking rock from the quarries to the Millennium Carillon and the 9-11 Memorial.



Together, the author and artist created an informative and beautifully illustrated book that describes Naperville's sparkling crown jewel and its importance in establishing the economic vitality of the city.

Naperville's Riverwalk: Where History and Community Flow Together honors the 175th anniversary of the city of Naperville, the 75th anniversary of Centennial Beach, and the 25th anniversary of the Riverwalk.

The 24-page book has a 4-color front and back cover. Its finished size is 8 ½ x 11 inches. While children are intrigued by the drawings that they can color and the features they can discover along the Riverwalk, adults also learn many facts about this important landmark that has enriched the community.
